



Choosing a Catholic Cemetery

When we are baptized, we are brought to a sacred place, a Catholic church, and baptized into the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection - thus giving us the promise of eternal life.

When one of our loved ones die, we take them to another sacred place, a Catholic cemetery, for burial in sacred ground while they await the resurrection of the dead and the promise of eternal life.

Burial in a Catholic cemetery is a statement of continued belief in that everlasting life, even in death.

Although a grave in a cemetery evokes sadness, a grave in a Catholic cemetery is also a sign of hope in God and His promise of everlasting life.




Burial Options

 - From Funeral Home
 - May be purchased from Catholic Cemeteries at time of need
 - Mausoleum
 - Requires Casket
 - From Funeral Home
 - Catholic Cemeteries provides Crypt Liner



Burial Options

- Cremated Remains
 - Mausoleum Niche
 - No outer container required
 - May be in urn (size restrictions apply)
 - Columbarium Niche
 - No outer container required
 - May be in urn (size restrictions apply)
 - In Ground
 - Requires Outer Container
 - From Funeral Home
 - May be purchased from Catholic Cemeteries at time of need



Full Body Weekdays before 2:00 pm \$1,300.00. Full Body Saturday and Holiday (if applicable) before 12:00 noon \$1,600.00. Saturday after 12 noon no later than 2:00 pm \$1,850.00. Cremains Weekdays before 2:00 pm \$875.00. Saturday cremains and Holiday (if applicable) \$1,400.00. Saturday after 12 noon and no later than 2:00 pm \$1,650.00.

Today, over half the purchases of burial space made in Catholic Cemeteries are made in advance of death (Pre-need).


The remainder of the purchases are made at the time of death (At-need).

Advantages of Pre-need planning


- Thoughtful planning and a sense of economic prudence.

Pre-need vs. At-need

Disadvantages of At-need purchase

- Immediacy of decisions.
 - Which cemetery
 - Cremation or full body
 - In-ground, mausoleum, columbarium
 - Location of gravesite in cemetery
- Your loved ones must pay in full prior to burial.
- Emotional decision making
