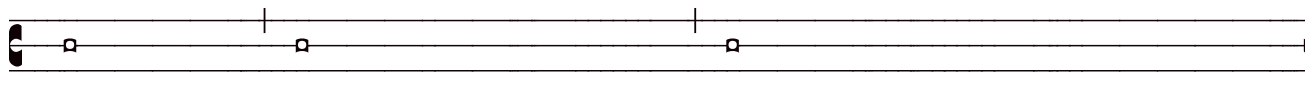
Since the Passover of the Jews was near, Jesus went up to Je-rusalem. He found in



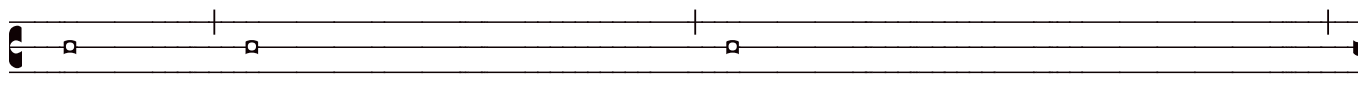
the temple area those who sold oxen, sheep, and doves, as well as the money-



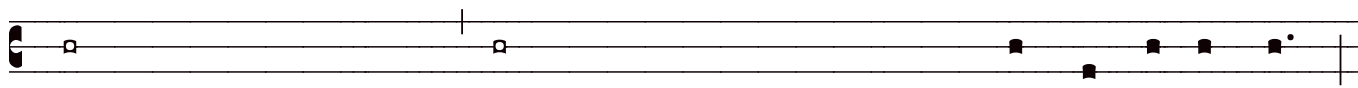
chan-gers seated there. He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the



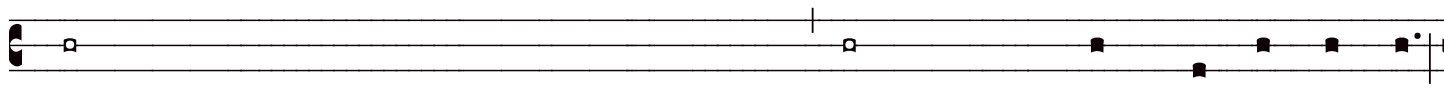
temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money-



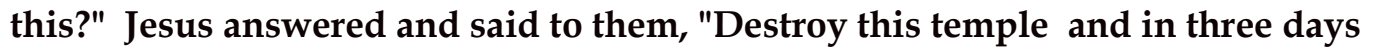
changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said,
