 Psalm 25a
 Of David
 1 In you, Lord my God,
 I put my trust.
 2 I trust in you, O Lord,

 nor let my enemies triumph over
 me.
 3 None who hopes in you
 will ever be put to shame,
 but shame will come on those
 who are treacherous without cause.
 4 Show me your way, O Lord,
 teach me your path.
 5 Guide me in your truth and teach me,
 for you are God my Savior,
 and my hope in you all day long.
 6 Remember, O Lord, your great mercy
 and love,
 for they are from of old.
 7 Do not let the sins of my youth
 and my rebellious ways
 according to your grace remember
 me, for your恩es are past.
 8 Good and upright is the Lord;
 therefore he instructs sinners in his
 ways.
 9 He guides the humble in what is right
 and teaches them his way.
 10 All the ways of the Lord are loving
 and faithful,
 toward all who keep the
 demands of his covenant.
 11 For the sake of your name, Lord,
 forgive my iniquity, though it is
 great.


